HOW TO REACH US

 Bergamo-Orio al Serio International Airport is connected to over 100 destinations and is Italy's third busiest airport for passenger numbers. It is located just 5 km from the city centre, so you can be in Bergamo in a matter of minutes. www.orioaeroporto.it

 There are frequent train connections with Milan and Brescia. The train station is located in the city centre. www.trenitalia.com

 Take the exit for Bergamo from the A4 Torino-Venezia highway.

GETTING AROUND

 Bergamo's funicular railways are a fast and easy way to get from one of the city's major attractions to another. From the Lower Town you can reach the Upper Town, and then, further up to San Vigilio Hill. www.atb.bergamo.it

 Bus number 1 and 1A take you to the Upper Town. From Bergamo airport you can reach the city with the Airport Bus. Take advantage of the tourist transport ticket for unlimited travel during your stay. www.atb.bergamo.it

 Upper Bergamo and the centre of Lower Bergamo are limited traffic areas. On Sundays and public holidays car traffic is prohibited between 10am-12pm and 2pm-7pm. With daylight savings time, access is also banned Friday and Saturday from 9pm-1am. www.comune.bergamo.it

BERGAMO FROM ABOVE
The Civic Tower, Torre del Caduti (Memorial Tower), the walls, the fortress, San Vigilio Hill... there are so many places where you can admire postcard landscapes. Indescribable must-see views.

PIAZZA VECCHIA
Here you can revive Bergamo's history. Palazzo della Ragione, the Civic Tower, S.Maria Maggiore Basilica, the Cathedral and the Colleoni Chapel compose the stunning quiet surrounding Piazza Vecchia. A square that according to Le Corbusier is "perfect, no need to touch a stone".



VENETIAN WALLS
Nominated as UNESCO World Heritage, the 5 km wall and its 4 majestic entrance gates make the Upper Town a unique part of the world. Walk around the walls to get a spectacular view stretching from the Apennines all the way to Milan.



GREEN BERGAMO
Bergamo is a unique city surrounded by 4,700 hectares of Parco del Coll'greenery. Here you can find the Astino Valley, home of a historic monastery. Discover the nature surrounding the city, following the numerous pathways that unveil the mysterious corners of Bergamo.
